BE STILL.

PRAY AND COMMIT YOUR TIME TOGETHER TO GOD.

Ask the Holy Spirit to guide your conversation and be prepared to listen and encourage each other as you bounce around thoughts and ideas. "...Be still and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."

If you want to respond together, choose one as a group that you can all align on before you move forward. "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith — and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God — ⁹not by works, so that no one can boast. ¹⁰For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

Perhaps this conversation has brought some issues to mind. Perhaps you would like to dig further into either the issues that have come up or just start to put together a plan of what to do next. One way of doing that is to start asking the following questions. Do it as a group or individually over the next few days and a plan will start to form.



The needs in the world can be overwhelming and so can the number of ways to respond to those needs. It's sometimes difficult to know where to even begin.

So with this in mind, lets dig a little deeper and seek to take personal ownership as a group of ONE thing that you can begin to do to make a felt difference in your community.

We use the following framework to help us respond in the most effective way -

REFLECT, RESPOND, RALLY.

USE THE FOLLOWING STEPS AS A GUIDE AND DISCUSS AND WRITE DOWN YOUR IDEAS



CORE PRINCIPLE "Do no harm" requires knowledge and planning not just good intentions

- Do your homework before taking action.
- Research, learn more about the issue you want to respond to before jumping in.
 - Ask a lot of questions
 - Remember that people are experts in their own lives. Avoid assumptions
 - Asking "why?" five times will often help you get to close to the root cause of a problem.
- Lean into the complexity. Solving social challenges isn't easy.
- What are you passionate about? (Pay altention to what you are repeatedly drawn to; makes you angry, or something you'd lave to see change)
 - Are you drewn towards issues facing children, sisters, or nations
 - Do you want to be a part of transforming your local neighbourhood, or engaging as a global citizen? Or both?
- What is your church's mission statement?
 - What areas does your church feel called to?
- What can you raily people around? What will those around you respond to?
- What sparks your curiosity and creativity?

- What do you have in your hands?
 Financial resources, time, spiritual gifts, networks, social media following, etc.
 What is your durant season of life?
- What is your sphere of influence?
- How can you use your vocation to seek justice?
- What's something unique you bring to the table?
- What are you really good at? What do you lose track of time doing?
- Who are the others already working in this space you may be able to join with?

RESPOND

CORE PRINCIPLE Relationship is everything! Genuine change can only be built on trust.

- What are the needs and how can you prioritise them?
- What can you learn from those who've gone before?
- Who is already doing great work and has relevant experience?
 - What are the opportunities for partnership?
 - Are there gap areas that you can fil?
- Who is on your team? Have the right people on board.
- What roles can you assign, playing to people's strengths?

REMEMBER THAT THOSE YOU ARE SEEKING TO SERVE ARE MADE IN THE IMAGE OF GOD, WITH EQUAL VALUE AND FULL OF POTENTIAL.

- How does your approach involve them, give them choice and empower them - not creating dependency?
- · Choose one small thing to start with.
- Don't try too many initiatives and hope that something sticks.

UNDER-PROMISE AND OVER-DELIVER.

 Get some small wins under your beit and don't raise expectations that you might not be able fulfil. Create a foundation that can be built upon.

- Be very clear on what you are asking of them and communicate the 'why'.

- Don't over promise to them either.
- Rally them for small practical things first.
- Don't be the hero!
- · Connect them with great organisations in your area that are doing it well.
- What stories can you share about what God is doing, which will inspire others to engage?
- Stories have the power to change hearts and minds.
