


WELCOME HOME.



THE WHOLE DAY IS THE MESSAGE







• GROUPS

As human beings, so much of our personal wellbeing has a direct link to our interaction with others. So, as a church, we regularly hang out together – and almost always around food! These meals take place in groups; most likely in people's homes, cafes, restaurants or pubs.

Groups are relational, personal and informal. They include having a meal together, praying for one another, and often include a discussion topic that is common to all our Groups.

Groups are an environment where people can connect and build life-long friendships. They are an environment where we accept as Jesus accepted, love as Jesus loved, forgive as Jesus forgave, and make allowances for others' faults, where the passing of judgment and gossip are considered antisocial and where treating others how you'd like to be treated is the rule of thumb.

Groups are that safe place where people can be known by others and get to know others, where people can share and process life experiences. Groups are not a place for theological debate or doctrinal dogma; these are best left for university and Bible College. Groups are also the basis of all the teams and departments of church life.

With Groups, we want everyone to be able to say, "Not only did I meet Jesus, but I came into an environment where people accepted me, where people cared about me, and where I was provided with an opportunity for me to contribute to the wellbeing of others and the collective whole." It is in this way that we can change the narrative of Jesus and his church in society.

Group Hangouts and Discussions

Along with getting together to hang out and have some food, our Groups include discussions, which are designed to be a way for the Group to talk about the things of God in an environment of encouragement, love and support. The Christian life was never meant to be done alone, and discussions in Groups can be a great way of growing in your faith alongside other people.

Bible Studies

As a church, we believe that as Christians we should be selffeeders who engage with the Bible not just on a Sunday but also during the week. To help people develop in their Bible reading we have Bible Studies, which take place during the week in people's houses. They are a place for dinner, studying Scripture, building relationships and encouraging each other in the Word of God.

Power Hours

Power Hours are similar in design and purpose to our usual Groups with one small exception. Created specifically for those people working in the city and/or working longer hours, these groups are focused on shorter, sharper connection and discussions and generally take place before work hours or during lunch breaks in board rooms and around the city. These Groups are limited to an hour in length, so you can fit them into even the busiest of working days.

HUMBLE

KIDS + FAMILIES

Hillsong Kids is our children's expression of Hillsong Church, where we provide a safe and engaging space for children to learn about Jesus and build great friendships with other children. Hillsong Kids exists to lead and encourage the kids in our church to live a Christ-centred life.

During our church services and events throughout the year, we provide an environment for children to experience the presence and love of God. Through age-specific programmes, our desire is that your children will build longlasting friendships, enjoy fun games, engaging stories, incredible worship, and Christ-centred Bible teaching. It is an honour to work alongside you as parents in creating special moments, which children will never forget, and it is our joy to play our part in raising champions of the future generations.

BUDDIES

Buddies is a fun, safe and engaging group for young children aged 1 (and walking) to 2 years old. Buddies is all about encouraging the children to make friends and become Buddies for life, through an interactive programme, which uses play, song, and craft activities to teach them the Word of God.

CHAMPIONS

Champions is a group for children aged 3 & 4 years old. Through games, craft, praise and worship, Bible stories, performances, and our discipleship small groups, your children will learn about the good news of God and His Church, in ways that are both simple and creative.

Champions is structured to allow for play, fun and, most of all, the opportunity for kids to develop a personal relationship with Jesus. Children are encouraged to reachout, care and love those in their world. Champions is the best place to be for kids who are starting school, as they learn how to deal with different situations and become Champions in life by putting Christ first.



HEROES

Heroes is our kids community for 5 & 6 year olds, where they learn about the Bible and how to grow in their relationship with God. We have engaging praise and worship, discipleship small groups, interactive games and activities, as well as Bible stories and teaching. It is a great place for children to develop healthy friendships and take their relationships with God to the next level. Our hope is that each child will come to know Jesus and become a hero in their world by sharing the love of God with those around them.

VOLTAGE

Voltage brings church to a whole new level for children aged 7-11 years old. Your child will love the interactive games, inspirational messages and powerful praise and worship, and they will grow in their understanding of God and who He is in their lives during our kids' discipleship groups. Our goal is to help your children live their faith out in a way that will influence their schools and communities, with their foundation firmly based in Christ.

Over the course of the final year in Hillsong Kids, your child will begin to meet, interact and build relationships with the Fuel team, which will help to prepare them and give them the confidence needed to make friends and transition into the early teenage years.

YOUTH

FUEL

Fuel is for everyone aged 11-14 years old (Years 7-9), and it is a brilliant opportunity for young people to be in a positive environment to learn about Jesus in a way that will empower them to make right choices, live out their dreams, and positively shape society.

At some locations, we have Refuel, which is our Sunday youth programme, which consists of games, small group time, and the preaching of the Word in a youth setting. At other locations, we join the main Sunday service and hang out for food and conversations straight after.

Throughout the year we have various youth nights and conferences where we gather together to worship and encounter God.

WILDLIFE

Wildlife is the 14-18 year old community of our church. We meet in homes across the UK to have dinner together every week, with youth leaders who will champion the young people in life. We call these small groups 'Crews'.

On Sunday, we all go to church together to either serve or attend one of our Sunday services. At different times in the year, our Crews gather together in one place for a local youth night, where we create opportunities for the young people to be involved with putting on the night; encouraging and releasing each young person into their God-given potential to positively shape society.

In addition to gathering for Sunday services we also have awesome youth nights and conferences throughout the year.

POWERHOUSE

Powerhouse is the community of our church for anyone aged 18-30. We meet together in homes for dinner every week, we have monthly social events across different locations, and we have regular nights of worship. Every summer we go away for a few days for our legendary Summerfest!



TECHNICAL PRODUCTION

Our Technical Production team exists so that you can hear what is said, sung and played, and so you can see who is saying it, singing it or playing it, all whilst making sure it is done in an excellent, distraction-free, engaging environment. Without the Technical Production team, Sundays would be a very different experience.

We do all of this so that people are able to enter into a powerful, personal encounter with God. Our goal is to create an atmosphere that is as awe-inspiring as entering St Paul's Cathedral. Production shouldn't just facilitate the basics but should inspire us to excellence.

Our hope is that when people come into church, regardless of what kind of week they have had, they find themselves in an atmosphere where everything is possible and where their focus is easily shifted from themselves to God. We do this by operating sound consoles, lighting desks, vision mixers, computers, placing items on stage, and making sure people are where they need to be at the right time; all while focussing on the people that are a part of the team accomplishing this. Interiors

Our Interiors team exists to create spaces that people want to spend time in. 





• FUEL





HUMBLE EMPATHETIC EMPOWERING INCLUSIVE & DIVERSE REAL COLLECTIVE SELF-INTEREST







When we look at the world we live in, it's clear that we live in a world of need. There are so many social needs, so many people being marginalised due to issues such as poverty, inequality, displacement and socio-economic barriers, and so many people in desperate need of help. As an individual, it's easy to find yourself in a place where you feel paralysed, asking "what can I do?", and "does my little bit make a difference?"

As a church, we know we can't do everything. Yet we are compelled to do something, and we believe that the little bit we do individually can make a lot of difference when we come together.

We call our social justice outreach 'Because We Can'. People may ask, why should we even try to change the world to make it a better place for the marginalised? And the answer is simple: it's because we can!

Imagine if every person within our church did one thing to help change the world for one person. Imagine if that one thing was done by tens of thousands of people; the result would be transformative! That's the goal - that each person in our church says "I'm going to do one thing to help change the world for somebody, to be consistent and sustain it over a period of time long enough to see change."

Imagine the possibilities, if tens of thousands of people worked together as one to change the world. Imagine if we all made a decision to impact and change the world for the 'one'. Because together, as we all change the world for the 'one', it's amazing how quickly that 'one' becomes a multitude, and it's amazing how quickly we can have an impact on making the world a better place.

'Because We Can' partnerships at a global level, and social justice initiatives at a local level do just that. We give everybody the opportunity to play their part in seeing social justice come to those who have been marginalised because of some form of injustice.

We have a handful of 'Because We Can' partnerships and 'I Care' initiatives, to which you can contribute a small amount on a monthly basis.

Global Partnerships - Because We Can

When it comes to the global issues in the world today, it can often all seem so far away and we can find ourselves asking the question "what difference can I make?" Through our global partnerships, we can actually make a difference vicariously.

Local Initiatives - Local Social Justice

We also have initiatives designed to meet the needs of the communities we find ourselves in. Local social justice is about making a decision to get involved in someone's life, and locating yourself in the need of another. You can get involved in this through financial contribution or volunteering.

GLOBAL PARTNERSHIPS

God-ordained partnerships take us beyond what any one of us could possibly hope to achieve on our own, aligning our own strengths with the experience of others who have measurable and strategic impact on the ground, to see God's purpose fulfilled in people's lives.

We partner with four global partners to see poverty and injustice eradicated: A21, Compassion, Hillsong Africa Foundation and Vision Rescue.



We partner with A21, who work to combat human trafficking around the globe. There are an estimated 40.3 million people around the world who are trapped in modern enslavement, and we want to play our part in releasing people into a life of freedom. By supporting A21 we play a part in preventing human trafficking through awareness and education, protecting survivors by providing a safe environment and by running restoration programmes in aftercare facilities.


COMPASSION

One of our global partnerships is with Compassion - an organisation that works to release people from poverty. As a church, we believe that if each of us decides to make a difference in the life of one person we could, together, impact a community, a region, and ultimately a nation. We have specific Hillsong child sponsorship projects in Uganda, where we partner with Compassion to bring people out of poverty and provide them with the resources they need to advance in life.

Over a third of the population of Uganda lives in extreme poverty, meaning that they live on less than USD \$1.90 a day, and often the people who are most affected by this poverty are the children who are born into it. Compassion Child sponsorship ensures that children attend church-based child development centres, where they receive nutritious food, health check ups, teaching, and training in life skills.

Another great challenge for many people in Uganda is water and sanitation. Over 80% of the population in Uganda lack a safe place to go to the toilet and 60% need to travel more than 30 minutes to access safe water. Through the 'Since The Water Came' project we identify where the need for clean water and sanitation is the greatest, and we set up water points and facilities that are life-saving, significantly reducing waterborne diseases among children and the wider community.

HILLSONG AFRICA FOUNDATION

The Hillsong Africa Foundation was born out of our church in Cape Town in 2009 in an attempt to respond to the vast array of challenges and needs in South Africa. Their projects transform communities in South Africa's townships and give hope to the destitute by restoring dignity and ending cycles of poverty, addiction and abuse. About half of South Africa's urban population live in townships and informal settlements where poverty is a way of life. The foundation is involved in many community projects such as food programmes, woman's shelters, wheelchair distribution and the Tembaletu school.

VISION RESCUE

In India, one of the biggest social issues is the cycle of generational poverty, in which children are born into poverty and are subsequently disadvantaged in life. More than 8 million children under 6 years old live in approximately 49,000 slums across India and a large number of these children remain out of the education system. In Mumbai, 47% of children from slum areas are chronically malnourished.

We partner with Vision Rescue, who offer practical help to the poorest of the poor to help break the cycle of poverty. They provide street children and their communities with access to education, sports programmes, healthy meals and basic medical care.

Local social justice is about making a decision to get involved in someone's life who lives in your community. It's about locating yourself in the need of another.

Loneliness, isolation and relational breakdown are major problems in our society. Through various initiatives and collaborations with existing local organisations we have teams and groups of people going out to those in our community who need help the most.

GREENLIGHT

As a church situated in some of the major cities of the UK, we know first-hand of the vulnerability of homeless people. Thousands of people in the UK sleep on the streets, and we have committed to being a part of the answer. The way we do this is by providing healthcare to the homeless population.

Improving healthcare is often a vital step out of homelessness, and something that we can offer to be a part of the answer to the great need that exists. We have two Greenlight Medical Vans that go onto the streets 7 days a week with a team of skilled volunteers, to provide minimally invasive medical care and a signposting service to help the homeless.



THE EMERGING GENERATION

In 2011 there was a significant social upheaval in the form of the London Riots, which in part reflected a generation that was struggling to construct a picture of hope for the future. Although today we may not see the same actions in the news, the challenge facing young people to construct a hope for their future is ever-present. As many as three quarters of a million young people in the UK say that they have nothing to live for, and we want to, as the church community, be the change and help young people to construct a brighter tomorrow.

As a church, we have three Youth Outreach projects:

Schools Project

The Schools Project aims to positively shape society by bringing a message of hope and inspiration to young people in secondary schools through dynamic presentations on topics such as identity, self-esteem, anti-bullying and relationships.

We follow this up with ongoing care and support for schools through a team of youth leaders, who provide workshops, courses and one-to-one mentoring.

Amplified Arts Academy

The Amplified Arts Academy is a performing arts academy which was launched to provide excellent, high quality and affordable education in the arts, taught by some of the industry's top professionals. It is set up with the belief that every young person should be given the opportunity to explore their passion for the arts, and that opportunities to progress in the entertainment industry should not be reserved solely for those who come from privilege.

Community Work

We partner with XLP, a charity that works with young people growing up on deprived inner city estates, with projects ranging from weekly community projects, to one-to-one mentorship and keeping young people in mainstream education. We help to make these projects a reality and have teams who volunteer in these community outreach projects.





As a church, we want to give every young person the same opportunities to make something of their life, and to grow into all that God has for them. We want to equip our young people with the skills and technical ability to make an impact in their chosen field, but also ensure that each student has the belief to step out in confidence, whilst carving their path in the creative industry.

Our creative classes offer a professional, safe and nurturing environment for all our students, where every individual matters. With students being placed in their class of 'best fit,' our tailored teaching programmes ensure that every student's potential is maximised, regardless of their level of entry.

REFUGEE RESPONSE

There are currently over 123,000 refugees in the UK; people who have been displaced from their homes as a result of violence, persecution or war. The vast numbers of refugees in our country poses an unprecedented challenge to the Church, particularly regarding how we best serve people who have been displaced from their homes.

We want to provide refugees in our communities with a warm welcome and support them in setting up life in the UK. By partnering with the Home Office and local organisations we have the opportunity to help newly arrived families and unaccompanied minors create a home, find their feet and learn the language and culture of their new country. The projects that we are currently involved in are:

Refugee Resettlement: Providing home and community for refugee families through the Community Sponsorship Programme of the Home Office.

Welcome Packs: A warm welcome in the form of a bag of essential items given to young refugees separated from family who come to the UK.

Spheres Workshops: Hosting workshops for refugees that will help them to gain useful life skills.

Football United: Weekly football sessions at various locations for young refugees where they can develop their football skills, friendships and confidence.



PERSONAL GROWTH

MAKING A DIFFERENCE"

CORPORATE GOVERNANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY

Hillsong Church London ('Hillsong Church') subscribes to a high standard of accountability and stewardship. The following procedures outline how the church is governed, structured and operated, and how it manages its financial and legal responsibilities.

Hillsong Church is a company limited by guarantee, registered as a charity with the Charity Commission. As a registered charity it is regulated by the Charity Commission and the church's governance structure and financial records are publicly available on the Charity Commission website.

Hillsong Church is governed by a board of trustees, who are the directors of the company. The board is responsible for the management of all the affairs of the church, which is carried out through regular meetings of the board. The primary responsibility of the Trustees is governance, which involves three main activities: compliance, assurance, and risk management.

The board is made up of leaders within Hillsong Church's congregation and, as outlined in the church constitution, no trustee is paid for carrying out their duties as a trustee of the church. Hillsong is an international organisation, with a global board. The Board of Trustees for Hillsong Church is accountable to the members of Hillsong Church. The appointment and removal of trustees is determined by the members, who are the directors of Hillsong internationally.

When it comes to the day to day management of the church, strict internal controls are applied: Two signatories are required for all payments; all purchase requests must be authorised by the Department Head and CFO; the Lead Pastors are not cheque or bank signatories; and all money received is counted by at least two people. Each department works to a budget approved by the board at the beginning of each year. The Church's financial results are reviewed at each board meeting. All significant purchases are tendered for competitive pricing. The financial plans of Hillsong Church are prepared with a spirit of faith and careful planning.

The church's financial records and systems are audited annually by a highly reputable large London based external audit firm, and audited financial statements are lodged both with The Charity Commission and Companies House.


GIVING





IN-SERVICE

At each of our services you'll find a Giving Envelope under your seat. Please follow the instructions on the envelope to complete your giving and place this in the container as it goes by.

GIFT AID

Gift Aid is a UK Government scheme, whereby the basic rate of UK tax that has already been deducted from the income you are giving to a charity is relinquished directly by HMRC to the charity you are giving to. As a registered charity, the church is able to claim Gift Aid on your giving. This means for every £1 that you give, the church can receive £1.25.

For the church to be able to make this claim, all you need to do is make a one-off declaration that you are a UK taxpayer.

If you give online, through the app or by text, please follow the instructions when you are prompted about Gift Aid. If you give by Standing Order, please go to our website and complete the declaration, to allow us to claim Gift Aid on your giving. To make a declaration or to find out more information, please visit www.hillsong.co.uk/giving/giftaid.

TAX DEDUCTIBILITY

If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate, you should be able to personally claim additional tax relief on your giving. To receive this you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return or

ask HMRC to adjust your tax code. If you would like a tax summary of your giving, please contact us at giving@hillsong.co.uk.

If you donate land, property or shares to a registered charity, you may also be eligible for Income Tax and Capital Gains tax relief on your gift.

Additionally, any giving to the church as part of a will, will be eligible to reduce any inheritance tax liabilities.

Hillsong Foundation, along with our annual once a year 'over and above' Heart For The House offering (an offering where everyone brings a financial contribution), allows us to equip the church with facilities, finance significant projects and contribute both to global social justice partnerships and local social justice initatives. It gives every person within church life a chance to participate financially, at any level, in seeing the vision of the church move forward.

HILLSONG FOUNDATION

You can be part of Hillsong Foundation at any level of giving, from a small monthly amount to those who say "I believe God has called me and gifted me to finance the vision of the church." The Foundation is split into three levels of contribution:

Kingdom Builders: Those who see themselves as financial leaders within the church and feel called to sacrifice accordingly to drive the vision forward. Kingdom Builders commit to a minimum amount over the year, fully detailed on our website (found below), that ends on Heart For The House Sunday.

Vision Impactors: Those who believe that they have the means to contribute and significantly impact the vision of what we could do in the UK and beyond. Vision Impactors also commit to a minimum amount over the year that ends on Heart For The House Sunday.

Army of Faithful Believers: This is where everybody can start. The Army of Faithful Believers contribute to the future and present by contributing on a monthly basis, or by being a part of the Heart For The House offering.

HEART FOR THE HOUSE

Heart For The House is our once a year offering, where we come together as a church to contribute over and above our normal giving. Heart For The House is also the culmination of our Foundation giving every year. It allows all of us to say "look what we have achieved as one." It's where we get to see the vision empowered, facilities become realities, projects come to be and lives impacted and transformed.
