



Worship Music

Our online worship stream is comprised of music workshops, focussed technique classes, music theory and worship music practice workshops. These are delivered through a combination of recorded masterclasses, self-directed studies and regular interactions with a trainer who specialises in your focus area. The aim of this course is to upskill individuals in their musical skills and spiritual development, to equip you to practically outwork in your local church. This includes feedback and coaching on how these practical skills are developed and transferred into your daily ministry.

Focuses:

Vocal Focus

Designed to equip vocalists who are talented and confident in ministering through their voice. Some areas of development are:

- Vocal anatomy and health
- Harmony
- Breathing
- Vocal tendencies: how to overcome consistent 'problem areas' of your voice quickly and effectively.
- Communication as a vocalist to an audience.
- Contributing to a worship team as a vocalist

Songwriting Focus

Designed to equip those who wish to minister through their musical and song writing capabilities in a Creative team context. Raising a generation of skilled and passionate songwriters who can collaborate with those around them. Some areas of development are:

- Developing lyric
- Creating melodies
- Effective chord progressions
- Rhythm and phrasing
- Contributing to a worship team as a vocalist or a musician

Musician Focus

Designed to equip those who wish to minister through their musical instrument.

We equip musicians to become a valuable resource in a team/band, both in a musical and leadership capacity. Some areas of development are:

- Song learning
- Effective soundcheck and rehearsal
- Dynamics and groove
- Music directing
- Using tracks
- Musical transitions
- Musical improvising
- Contributing to a worship team as a musician

Our courses are structured to equip you with the ministry and musical industry standard practices, skills, and knowledge. Ultimately, we hope to prepare students for a lifetime of excellence in service to the Church and to cultivate a heart for worship.
